IIM-National Metallurgist Award (IIM APEX Award-Through Solicitation)
Year Established: The IIM-National Metallurgist Award was established in 2025
Periodicity: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only one award will be made each year.• In the absence of a suitable candidate in the year under consideration, the Apex committee may not give the award that year.
Posthumous Selection: The award shall not be given posthumously.
Description of the Award: The IIM-National Metallurgist Award shall be conferred upon an outstanding metallurgical engineer, materials scientist, researcher, or academician or an industrial leader in recognition of his/her significant contributions over the last 10 years . The award also recognizes specific original work that has a significant impact on the national scenario and is predominantly carried out in India.
Purpose of the Award: To recognize and honour individuals who have made outstanding and sustained contributions to the field of metallurgy, materials science and engineering.
Eligibility: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The award is limited to Indian citizens only.• Persons of eminence, working in any field connected with metallurgy, materials science and engineering shall be eligible for the Award.
IIM Membership: Preferably a Member
Singular/Joint Award: Singular
Age: Between 40-60 as on 10 th November of the year of Award
Qualifications: Any degree relevant to Metallurgy/Materials Science profession is preferred
Presentation: A memento accompanied with a scroll of Honor and will be presented to the recipient during the IIM Award Ceremony during IIM-ATM.
Selection Guidelines: The Apex committee will solicit nominations from its members and will finally recommend a candidate for the Award based on a discussion in the Apex Committee.
The National Council of The Indian Institute of Metals will be the sole authority to ratify the recommendations of the Apex Committee.
