



IIM Core Awards

GREENKO TIIM Best Technical Paper Award in Sustainability category
Year Established: The GREENKO TIIM Best Technical Paper Award in Metal Science Category is being instituted in 2026, aligned to the TIIM Best Technical Paper Awards in Ferrous, Non-Ferrous and Metal Sc. Categories respectively.
Periodicity: Only one award will be given every year.
In the absence of a suitable candidate in the year under consideration, the Council may not give the award that year.
Posthumous Selection: Awards shall not include posthumous selection.
Description of the Award Award Prize Money of Rs. One Lakh Every Year, along with a Scroll of Honor.
Purpose of the Award: To acknowledge the contributions made through - research and development work by eminent metallurgist, whose work has been accepted for publication in Metal Science Group, in the Transactions of The Indian Institute of Metals.
Eligibility:
Contributions & Achievements: Technical papers published in the Transactions in the preceding year of the year in which the award is made, are eligible for this award. Papers in Sustainability group published in the Transactions are eligible for consideration.
IIM Membership: Not Mandatory (Individuals from Indian Origin will only be considered)
Singular / Joint: The Award shall be presented to the principal author of the best technical paper published in the Transactions. Co-authors will be in receipt Certificate of Merit.
Age: Open.
Qualifications: Preferred: Bachelor's degree in Metallurgy / Engineering / Materials Science or equivalent, or any degree relevant to Metallurgy / Materials Science profession.
Nominations: A Committee constituted by the Chief-Editor Transactions, primarily to assess technical papers shall send proposal in order of merit to the IIM Awards Committee.
Presentation: The Award will be formally presented to the recipient during the Annual Technical Meeting of The Indian Institute of Metals. Co-authors are presented with a Certificate of Merit.
Selection Committee Guidelines: The IIM Awards committee as approved by the Council shall meet to consider the proposal of the Committee and make its recommendations to the National Council. The Council of The Indian Institute of Metals will be the sole authority to decide the recipient from the recommendations submitted by the Awards Committee.
